BILATERAL ANKLE X-RAYS

Clinical History:

Right syndesmotic injury.? Asymmetry.

Findings:

The recent CT was reviewed.

The syndesmosis measures 4.7mm in width on the right (within normal limits) and 6.4mm (mildly widened) on the left. Interpretation is therefore complicated. Has there been previous ankle/syndesmotic injury on the left? Alignment otherwise appears normal within the ankle mortise bilaterally. No evidence of arthropathy. No fracture is detected.

There is a sclerotic focus in association with the lateral left tibial meta diaphysis. Interpretation is difficult with only a single projection available. There is associated mild cortical thickening but slight irregularity of the endosteal surface also. The lesion is well circumscribed and overall, favoured to reflect a non-ossifying fibroma.
